This is a major fundraiser for the band. We would like to see as many parents as possible participate in this event. Volunteers arrive about 1 hour before the gates open. You are responsible to count all

products and keep a record of the starting inventory. Generally six volunteers will handle the cash registers. We sell burgers or pizza, plus things like fries, chicken, candy etc. One volunteer will be responsible for all cash for the event. That volunteer will monitor sales, track over-rings etc. You will reconcile the cash at the end of the evening. Volunteers count the inventory again at the end of the evening and clean the stand. Volunteers will be required to sell alcohol. RBC does require each volunteer to take part in an ALE training class offered at the RBC center.
